# Atlantic Iowa Police Department

"There are 12 officers on the Atlantic Police Department, 4 of them with bad backs and the other 8 on their way to bad backs," according to Chief Roger Muri. That factor alone was enough to convince the department, located in southwest Iowa, to install Pro Copper seats in its 4 police cruisers.
